If you complete 15 credit hours of required courses per term you could finish the 180 credit hours required to graduate in 4 years. If you complete more credit hours per term or attend Summer session, you would graduate sooner. If you complete less than 15 credits per term, the length of time it would take to graduate would be longer than 4 years.
