

Bookstore Voucher

Students who have applied for financial aid, but not yet received their award may be eligible for a bookstore voucher that can be used for purchasing books and/or supplies at the Wolfstore. Bookstore vouchers will be available beginning on the first day of term in either the Financial Aid or Business Services offices. All items purchased with a bookstore voucher will be charged directly to the student's account and will be subject to the Revolving Charge Contract.

To be eligible for a bookstore voucher, a student must:

1. Have a valid FAFSA/ISIR on file with the Financial Aid Office. If any outstanding forms/documents are required to complete their file, they must be aware of these and in the process of submitting them.

2. Be registered for at least 1 credit at the time of the voucher request.

3. Have photo ID.

We recommend that students price their course materials (either in store or via the website) prior to requesting a bookstore voucher. This way a student will know exactly how much to request, which is generally limited to \$700 per term. Exceptions will be handled on a case-by-case basis by either the Director of Business Services or the Director of Financial Aid.
