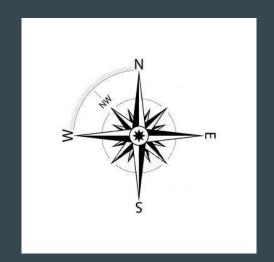

## **Our Mission**

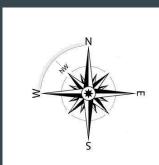

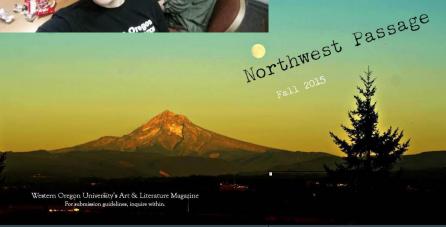
## **Northwest Passage**

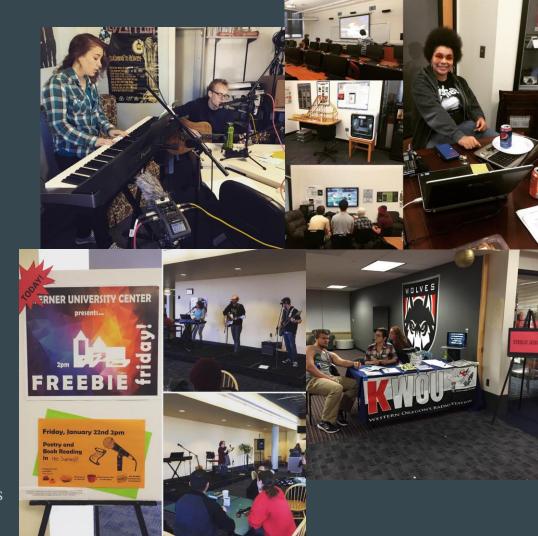

## **Funding**

#### Good News:

- **★** Salary Savings
- ★ Grant prevents need for enhancements
- ★ Requesting base funding
- ★ Printing fewer physical copies of The Journal

#### Less than great:

- ★ If cuts are required:
  - o Travel eliminated; grants will be required
  - Some student roles will need to be temporarily eliminated:
    - Journal Designer (1 @ 5%, 10%)
    - Journal Copy Editor (@ 10%)
    - KWOU Tech. Engineer (@10%)
  - o Printing fewer issues of all publications
